Selected candidates must join the project immediately.

The tenure of appointment shall be for a period of one year or less (as per requirement in the project). This can be extended in steps upto a maximum of three years duration. The nature of the appointment is purely temporary on a contract basis for 3 year and co- terminus with the project. The appointee shall have no claim for regularising the service at the University at a later date nor will the University at any point of time entertain any claim by the candidate for extension of term or re-appointment or regularisation of job.
